



Cleco Pads to Keep From Marring Your Skins

When using clecos on your aircraft skins, they will sometimes scratch and mar the surface with little round scratches and divots. They sell individual rubber caps, that cost about 30 cents each (as much as the cleco almost).

What I did was purchase a roll of double-sided pads, or single side stick if you can find it. I cut them into little squares and placed them on the end of the cleco to protect the skins. Cheap and effective!
